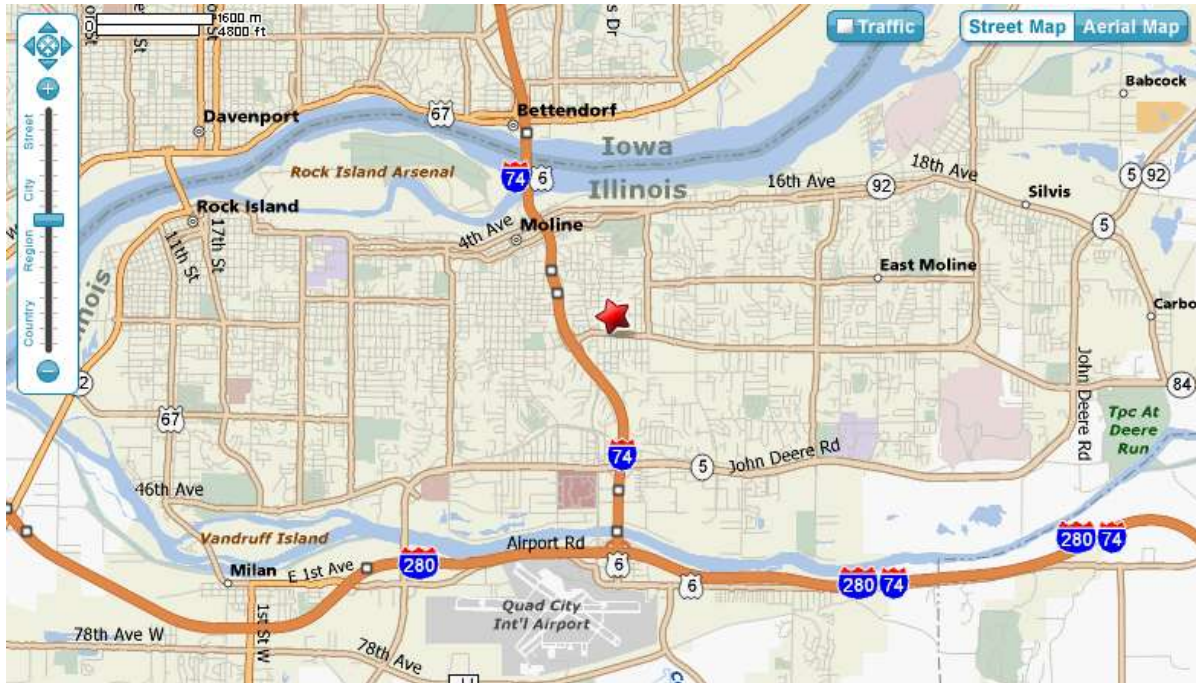

Another is to set up our Web site to accept credit card donations online (no more scrounging for an envelope and stamp). We’ll be looking into these, but I know there are other ideas out there worth crowing about. A Babe-Chick Bake Sale maybe? A Rooster Relay? Let us know all about them!

We know money is as tight as Spanx on a walrus these days, but we want to make certain no one misses an opportunity to attend a VdC weekend because the budget won’t allow it. Can you ever forget how your weekend was for you? It’s been over 13 years in my case, and the memory of it still fills me with joy. These weekends are designed to provide faith renewal for Christians by grounding them more fully in God’s grace and in the disciplines of prayer, study and service. It is our hope that participants in the weekend will return to their home parishes renewed and better equipped to serve their church as leaders. Therefore we expect participants in the weekend to be active members of their church. Like Marriage Encounter, which seeks to strengthen healthy marriages rather than heal troubled ones, Via de Cristo is designed to strengthen faith rather than provide spiritual conversion for a struggling Christian.
